





Award For Excellence






Happy Birthday,



Dressed in their smart attires, the young Marians looked confident and ready to face the world beyond. St. Mary's wishes its outgoing batch the very best in life.


















My First Experience in Cooking


My vacation of class seven I decided to cook, for what heaven! Towards the kitchen I was going Determined of some great doing.
