Late entry for any reasons will not be considered. • Entries will be judged on the basis of the following criteria: Interpretation & clarity of the theme to the viewer, Creativity & originality of the depicted story, Quality of artistic composition /design, Overall impression of the art. • The decision of the judges will be final.

Class 6 on 3rd July Class 7 on 4th July Class 8 on 5th July• The dance form should be purely folk or classical or western, as per your choice of dance form with proper costume and make up.• The song should be<ol style="list-style-type: none">(i) Non filmy folk song (For Folk dance)(ii) Classical (for classical dance form)(iii) Filmy/Non filmy song (For western dance form)<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No previously recorded performance will be accepted.• Participants may perform on a recorded track.• Participants should start the video by stating their category (Classical/folk/ western) name, their class and after this; they may immediately commence their performance. Please ensure that the video (indoor) has a decent lighting and audio quality.<p>* Participants for final round (4 participants per dance form) will be informed by 13th July.</p>
